## Information Sheet QR Working in the Electrified Territory (WET)



This training is required for persons seeking a Rail Industry Worker (RIW) card for rail work in the Queensland Rail Network.

This course is an entry level induction for all persons wanting to work within the Queensland Rail electrified territory. It provides detailed knowledge about the electric traction system and how to work safely in the electrified territory.

JMDR are licensed by Queensland Rail to deliver this induction training package which includes specific training and assessment aligned to working in the Queensland Rail Realm.

**Please note:** Other jurisdictions may require alternate or additional training/inductions to gain the required RIW card role for work.

### Learning Outcomes:

On successful completion of this course, participants will:

- Gain an understanding of electric traction system, relevant electrical risks and how to work safely in the electrified territory to prevent injuries and avoidable incidents.
- Certificate of Achievement

### QR3.15 Working in the Electrified Territory Electric Traction Safety Card

### Requirement for attending Training:

Learners will be required to display adequate core skills of being able to learn, read, write, and take part in oral communication and numeracy.

To attend training, you must:

- Provide a government issued form of photo identification
- Have confirmed enrolment details
- Meet any requirements set out in the enrolment confirmation

**Training** includes face to face learning, demonstration, and discussion. Training and Assessment is delivered using QR courseware aligned QR rules, regulations and other requirements.

### Assessment

Learning and assessment activities will be conducted by our trainer/assessor using a range of evidence gathering techniques throughout the course, including written and practical demonstrations. Assessment includes both written theory (short answer, multiple choice, true/false) and practical observation assessments. You must achieve a satisfactory result in each to receive a Statement of Attainment for the nationally endorsed competency TLIF0020 Safely access the rail corridor.

### Fees and Enrolment:

The course fee is **\$200 inc. GST.**

The course fee includes workbook and assessment material.

Participants must provide payment, a **completed enrolment form, agree to our terms and conditions** before training commences.

**Additional costs** apply for an RIW card application.

**Please note** – The following requirements apply for work in the rail corridor:

- Successfully Complete QR Safely Access the Rail Corridor (**3.2 SARC**)
- Hold a valid Trackside safety card
- Hold TLIF2010 Apply fatigue management strategies
- Hold a Valid CAT 3 or above Medical
- Hold a Valid RIW Card with the following roles:
  - QR – Operator
  - Around the Track (Construction)

For work in QR Electrified areas you must also hold Working in Electrified Territory card (**3.15 WET**)

Upon successful completion of training, **applicants must arrange** with an employer/registered organisation to apply for (or add this competency to) a Rail Industry Worker (RIW card). This will require a:

- A Category 3 medical certificate which is current for a period of 5 (five) years issued by a Medical Practitioner authorised by RIW.

- A 100-point id check
- A Statement of Attainment for TLIF0020 Safely access the rail corridor.

**Please note:** The cost for issue of an RIW card (and annual subscription) is additional to the course fee and payable to the RIW card provider (refer [www.riw.net.au](http://www.riw.net.au)).
