### **CPCCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry**

This unit of competency is from the Nationally Endorsed CPC40110 Certificate 1 in Construction.

#### **Course overview:**

The unit CPCCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry is the unit of competency, which has been developed to meet the requirements of the National Code of Practice for Induction for Construction Work and provides a basic introduction to Work Health & Safety in order to work safely in the construction industry.

#### **Learning Outcomes:**

Participants will gain the following skills and knowledge at the end of course and will be able to:

- Identify WHS legislative requirements
- Identify construction hazards and control measures
- Identify WHS communication and reporting processes
- Identify WHS incident response procedures.

Participants will gain understanding of the requirement to work safely in the construction and similar industries, including communication, work planning, and basic use of tools and materials

Up on successful completion of training participants will receive a:

- Statement of Training (SOT) from SafeWork NSW (The SOT is valid for a period of 60 days pending the issue of the SafeWork **White Card**/ General Construction Induction Training (GIT) card.
- Statement of Attainment for CPCCWHS1001 Prepare to work safety in the construction industry.

The course is a mandatory requirement as WHS induction training within the construction industry and meets WHS regulatory authority requirements for WHS induction.

#### **Requirement for attending Training:**

Prior to commencing training for a Safely access the rail corridor program the applicants must:

- Have confirmed enrolment and paid the course fees
- Complete 100 (one hundred) points of identification
- Provide a valid USI.
- Bring a pen to take notes and complete the assessment

#### **Location:**

The training is conducted at our training rooms in the Sydney CBD, and short walk from Central Station at Level 12, 477 Pitt St, Sydney, NSW 2000.

**WHEN:** Training is held weekly commencing 8am. Actual days will be confirmed pending class schedule, availability, and enrolment numbers.

## Duration

### **Actual days available on request pending class size.**

Attendance of a minimum 6 hours of face-to-face learning and completion of assessment tasks is mandated by SafeWork NSW in order to complete this unit of competency and qualify for a SafeWork NSW White Card. Six (6) hours of face-to-face learning does not include breaks.

You will be required to arrive 15 minutes ahead of the nominated start time to confirm all enrolment details are completed.

## Assessment

Learning and assessment activities will be conducted by our assessors using a range of evidence gathering techniques throughout the course, including written and practical demonstrations. Your trainer will provide you with any support you may require with your assessment throughout the training.

You must pass the theory and practical knowledge assessment to receive a Statement of Attainment (SoA) and SafeWork NSW Statement of Training (SOT).

If you are assessed as “Not yet competent” on the first attempt, you will be given another opportunity to demonstrate your competence. If you are still not successful after this, you may need to reenroll and repeat the unit of work.

## Course support available:

If you have any special requirements during the training or assessment, please speak to one of our personnel so that we are able to advise and assist you where applicable. ## Fees and Enrolment:

The course fee is **\$160** and includes workbook and assessment material and, upon successful completion of the course, issue of temporary SOT, and SafeWork NSW White/GIT Card when issued by SafeWork NSW.

Participants must provide payment, a **completed enrolment form and USI number** before training day.

## Issue of WorkCover GIT Card:
